EU Regulation 2016/679: Articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 - Rights of the Data Subject

- 1. The data subject has the right to obtain confirmation of the existence or non-existence of personal data concerning them, even if not yet recorded, their communication in an intelligible form, and the possibility to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority.
- 2. The data subject has the right to obtain the following information:
 - a) the origin of the personal data;
 - b) the purposes and methods of processing;
 - c) the logic applied in case of processing carried out with the aid of electronic instruments;
 - d) the identification details of the data controller, data processors, and the designated representative pursuant to Article 5, paragraph 2;
 - e) the subjects or categories of subjects to whom the personal data may be communicated or who may become aware of it as the designated representative in the territory of the State, data processors, or persons in charge.
- 3. The data subject has the right to obtain:
 - a) updating, rectification, or, when there is an interest, data integration;
 - b) erasure, transformation into anonymous form, or blocking of data processed unlawfully, including data that does not need o be retained for the purposes for which the data was collected or subsequently processed;
 - c) confirmation that the operations referred to in points a) and b) have been brought to the attention, including their content,
 of those to whom the data has been communicated or disclosed, except where this proves impossible or involves a use of
 means manifestly disproportionate to the right being protected;
 - d) data portability.
- 4. The data subject has the right to object, in whole or in part:
 - a) for legitimate reasons to the processing of personal data concerning them, even if relevant to the purpose of the collection;
 - b) to the processing of personal data concerning them for the purpose of sending advertising or direct sales material or for carrying out market research or commercial communication.
